THE RECEPTION

OPENING HOURS

Open from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and from 1:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

This is the ideal place to find information if you are unsure about something, have a question, or encounter a problem.

- Garbage bags:
 - Large bags €2/bag - €20/roll
 - Small brown bags €1.5/bag - €30/roll
- Barbecue: \$8/day or \$20/stay + \$50 deposit (refunded to your bank account after your stay)
- Sep-key badge: (sanitary facilities) €75 deposit + you can load the amount onto your card at reception.

For all bread and pastry orders, please visit Stock & Sevrin, located just opposite the campsite.

ATTENTION!

- BBQs must be reserved before midday! And brought back.
- Campfires are prohibited!
- Campsite trash bags must be used!
- Access to the grounds means that you may be filmed by security cameras installed on site.





ACCOMMODATIONS

We kindly ask you to respect these rules in the accommodations:

- Smoking is prohibited in your accommodation!
- Dogs are not allowed on the chairs or beds.
- The furniture and equipment belong to the accommodation. Under no circumstances may they be moved to another accommodation.

All our rental caravans are equipped with a television screen to which you can connect your PC or mobile phone using an HDMI cable and an adapter, available for hire at reception.

FISHING AROUND THE POND

All fishermen are welcome at our domaine. In order to preserve aquatic wildlife and ensure everyone's safety, fishing is strictly regulated. The complete rules and regulations are posted around the pond and available on our website. You must read them before applying for a permit, which you must have in your possession before you start fishing.

Main rules and regulations to be observed:

Access to the pond is prohibited before 7 a.m. for all anglers.

Night fishing is **prohibited**.

A maximum of **two** lines per angler.

Braided line is prohibited.

Hooks must be size 10, 12 or 14 without barbs.

Fish must be unhooked on a wet fishing mat, available at reception (€15).

Each fish must be returned to the water immediately and carefully using a landing net or mat.

Children must be accompanied by an adult.

In the event of a violation, the fishing permit may be withdrawn without refund.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in ensuring that this activity remains enjoyable and respectful for all.



LEISURE

- Children's playground: free of charge
- Table tennis: free of charge/equipment hire: €2 + ID as a deposit
- Tennis: free for one hour, booking required at reception/equipment hire: €5 + ID as a deposit
- Pétanque: free of charge
- Children's entertainment: free of charge, programme available at reception
- Carp fishing at the Carpodrôme: €13/day - €35/week - €85/year. **You must consult the rules before fishing!**
- Trout fishing on the River Aisne: €20/day
- Please note: a fishing licence is required for the Aisne (Walloon region).



ANIMATION

Depending on the time of year you stay at the estate, various activities are offered at the campsite. These activities are suitable for children of all ages. Adults can also take part in certain activities, such as bingo, campfires, torchlight walks, etc. A new programme is available at reception every week. On the website, you can find out what there is to do and when: live music, evening events, etc.



ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE

Accommodation:

Check-in after 3.30 p.m.

If the gas bottle is empty, please inform reception. We will then come and replace the bottle. It is forbidden to change the boiler settings. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact reception.

Departure before 10:30 a.m. (Entrance gate: 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. Exit gate: 24 hours a day)

At the end of your stay, we ask that you:

- Leave the caravan or tent clean
- Set the heating to 5°C or the minimum setting (position 1).
- Return the garden furniture and parasol to the garden shed.

Pitches:

Arrival after 1.30pm.

Departure before 12 midday. Please clean your pitch and leave it in the same condition as when you arrived. No rubbish or discarded items may be left on site.

CHEMICAL TOILETS

There are specific areas on the estate where you can empty your chemical toilet or dispose of grey water.

Do not do this in a sink!

If you are unsure of the correct location, please do not hesitate to ask.

SANITARY FACILITIES

There are three toilet blocks on the site (ask for a map at reception for more information). Please be considerate of others and keep these areas clean when using them. Before leaving the toilet block, always check that you have not left anything behind.





TRAFFIC

It is strictly forbidden to drive on the tourist tram tracks. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the police being notified immediately.

Many children play on our campsite, so please drive carefully! The speed limit is **10 km/h.**

In addition, cars must be parked on **your own pitch** or in **the car park.** **Maximum 2 cars** per pitch.



DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Dogs must always be kept on a leash, with the exception of our own animals, and are not allowed in the pond. You can walk your dog outside the campsite, to the right after the railway line (woodland). Please remember to take bags with you to pick up after your dog. Obviously, animals are not allowed in the sanitary facilities.

We have set up a fenced-in park where you can let your dog play off the leash, but always under your supervision.

It is mandatory to pick up your dog's waste and dispose of it in the bins provided for this purpose. You will also find one of these bins near the pond. The park is located next to the basketball court and pétanque court on the other side of the river.



WASTE

The sorting centre is open under supervision every day from 9am to 11am. We would like to remind everyone that there are certain rules for disposing of waste.

- Only use the waste bags available at the estate reception.
- Sort your waste:
 - > PMC (separate plastic caps)
 - > Tins, cans
 - > Food waste
 - > Cardboard. Flatten the cardboard before disposing of it.
 - > Glass
- Limit waste production
- Only dispose of household waste produced during your stay on the estate.
- Grass and other bulky waste must be taken to the municipal recycling park.
- You are required to take bulky items home with you.

CHARGING STATIONS FOR ELECTRIC CARS

We have installed two electric charging stations in our restaurant car park. These stations allow you to charge your vehicle easily and safely.

This means you can enjoy all the benefits of electric driving without worrying about your battery life during your holiday in the Ardennes.

The stations are accessible 24 hours a day for guests staying at the campsite.

For other guests, access is available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and/or during restaurant opening hours. This means you can enjoy a drink or a good meal while your car is charging.

Your electric vehicles must be charged exclusively via the charging stations provided for this purpose. It is strictly forbidden to charge your electric or hybrid vehicles on your pitch.

NATURE ACTIVITIES



Nisramont Dam

If the rivers are too dry for boating, you can always head to Lake Nisramont. The beautiful valley can not only be admired by kayak, but is also worth a visit for experienced hikers.

Climb a few metres and you will be rewarded with breathtaking views.

Maboge beach

Looking for a spot by the river where you can cool off? You'll find plenty of space here. Maboge beach is a meadow by the Ourthe river and part of La Roche-en-Ardenne, where you can have lots of fun on the water.

The caves of Hotton

Less well known but just as beautiful as the caves of Han-sur-Lesse, they will take you 65 metres underground, where you will find an underground river and look out over a 30-metre chasm. The tour takes about 3½ hours. The average temperature is 12°C, so don't forget to wrap up warm.

Riveo – River Interpretation Centre

Riveo invites you to discover the river and its natural environment. Here you will find aquariums, activities and exhibitions on the theme of the river. You can also enjoy 1,500 m² of remarkable gardens and a mini golf course.
